

TOWN OF CORNWALL **SPRING RUBBISH PICK-UP**

THE TOWN OF CORNWALL'S BULK RUBBISH PICK-UP WILL BEGIN **MONDAY, APRIL 19, 2010**. RESIDENTS ARE REQUESTED TO PUT ITEMS TO BE PICKED UP AT CURBSIDE **NO EARLIER THAN THE WEEKEND PRECEDING THE PICK-UP**. THE TOWN'S CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ENFORCES THIS. REGULAR GARBAGE & RECYCLING PICK-UP SCHEDULES WILL BE MAINTAINED AND, THEREFORE, RESIDENTS ARE REQUESTED TO KEEP HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE & RECYCLING SEPARATE FROM RUBBISH. **IF RESIDING ON A PRIVATE ROAD, LEAVE RUBBISH ON THAT PRIVATE ROAD.**

1. A MAXIMUM OF 1 CUBIC YARD (3'x3'x3') OF SMALL ITEMS AND MISCELLANEOUS DEBRIS WILL BE PICKED UP FROM EACH RESIDENCE.
2. SMALL ITEMS AND MISCELLANEOUS DEBRIS MUST BE IN CONTAINERS WEIGHING **NOT MORE THAN 25 LBS**. LOOSE PILES OF TRASH WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
3. OBJECTS LONGER THAN **SIX FEET** WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
4. NO MORE THAN ONE (1) MAJOR APPLIANCE WILL BE PICKED UP AT ANY ONE HOUSEHOLD.
5. NO MORE THAN ONE (1) PIECE OF HOUSEHOLD FURNITURE WILL BE PICKED UP AT ANY ONE RESIDENCE.
6. RESIDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP APPLIANCES, FURNITURE AND SCRAP METAL SEPARATE FROM BULK TRASH.
7. NO MORE THAN FOUR (4) TIRES WITH RIMS REMOVED

PROHIBITED ITEMS

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP

- NO** CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND RESIDUE
- NO** DEMOLITION DEBRIS
- NO** TREE TRUNKS, TREE LIMBS, LOGS, TIMBER, LUMBER
- NO** AUTOMOTIVE COMPONENTS
- NO** REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS, OR ANY APPLIANCE UTILIZING "FREON" TYPE REFRIGERANTS
- NO** RECOGNIZABLE QUANTITIES OF ANY SUBSTANCE CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC MATERIAL OR ANY CONTAINER OF UNIDENTIFIABLE MATERIAL
- NO** PROPANE TANKS OF ANY SIZE
- NO** COMPUTER MONITORS
- NO** TELEVISIONS

NO RETURN TRIPS WILL BE MADE

REMINDER:

TIRES MUST HAVE RIMS **REMOVED** TO BE PICKED UP

PILES OF **LOOSE TRASH WILL NOT** BE PICKED UP

REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS, WILL NOT BE PICKED UP

RESIDENTS MAY BRING THESE ITEMS TO THE ORANGE COUNTY TRANSFER STATION IN NEWBURGH, DURING NORMAL OPERATING HOURS, MON.-FRI. BETWEEN 7AM-4 PM, SAT. BETWEEN 7AM – NOON, AT A COST OF \$15 PER APPLIANCE.

PROPANE TANKS OF ANY SIZE **WILL NOT** BE PICKED UP. RESIDENTS MAY BRING THEM TO THE ORANGE COUNTY TRANSFER STATION AT A COST OF \$2 EACH.

COMPUTER MONITORS & TELEVISIONS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. RESIDENTS MAY BRING THESE ITEMS TO THE ORANGE COUNTY TRANSFER STATION IN NEWBURGH (374-1925) DURING NORMAL OPERATING HOURS MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY. FIRST ITEM OF THIS TYPE NO CHARGE, \$5 CHARGE FOR ADDITIONAL ITEM.
