Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M.

Supervisor QUIGLEY thanked everyone for attending, and advised that we were scheduled to be given a presentation on the possibility of a university being built in the Town of Cornwall. Unfortunately due to the snow, the gentleman in question could not make it to tonight's meeting. Supervisor QUIGLEY further advised that he would try schedule this for a later time. Supervisor QUIGLEY stated that the basic overview is that a Greek University would be built on the grounds of the New York Military Academy, with further development in retail and residential space, similar to a mini village area. The school would create jobs and he believes that it would be a win-win situation for the Town. Legislator Chris Eachus asked if the supervisor had spoken with NYMA regarding this. The Supervisor answered that he had briefly spoken with them months ago and that they let him know what it was they were looking to do. NYMA wanted to know if we as a Town would give it the thumbs up, and if so, they would then go on through the normal process. Supervisor QUIGLEY advised that NYMA would remain and that this would probably be helpful to bolster their financial position. Legislator Eachus asked if the supervisor knew what the difference was between a university and a Greek university. Supervisor QUIGLEY advised that he was not sure but that it was open to all and would be non-denominational. Mr. Led Klosky asked if the Supervisor knew what sites were considered. Supervisor QUIGLEY advised that he was not sure and that we should wait until the presentation.

Supervisor QUIGLEY announced that there would be an insurance meeting on Thursday, February 25th 2010 at 7:00 P.M.

There being no further business to conduct, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilwoman KRAFFT, seconded by Councilman MAZZOCCA.
