

**PROCLAMATION OF EXTENSION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
PURSUANT TO §24 OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW
OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK**

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor, as the Chief Executive Officer of the Town of Cornwall, is empowered to proclaim a local state of emergency within the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall pursuant to the provisions of Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law for a period of up to thirty (30) days; and


WHEREAS, due to the existing pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19) a local state of emergency was declared in the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall on June 11, 2020 and was extended through May 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the Declaration of State of Emergency for an additional period of thirty (30) days due to the continuance of the pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19);

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Supervisor of the Town of Cornwall and pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, I do hereby proclaim that the existing state of emergency shall continue until June 6, 2021, unless a proclamation lifting the state of emergency is issued at an earlier date.
